Third broods a rarity

As the chart above shows, third broods occur only about 1% of the time, and then, primarily where the climate is conducive to nesting over the longest periods. No wonder then that Orange County accounted for 63% of all WEBL 3rd broods. Of the 19 reported, 12 were from Orange, 4 from San Mateo, 2 from Amador, and 1 from Santa Clara.

Only 40% of bluebird pairs attempted a second nesting.

To be technical, without banding we really can't be sure of second and third broods. They may be birds that got a late start and missed the first nesting period. Perhaps no box was available until another pair had fledged. Most are probably valid and we report them as such while leaving the question open.

Where have all the bluebirds (monitors) gone?

Those of us responsible for this report and publication are used to delays, but this year seems to have been worse than most. We have a new editor. She had the winter issue ready to go out around Christmas. With fewer duties, Judy and I geared up to get this annual report out around Thanksgiving.

Was it the national election, a hard winter? When we made the first tabulation, there were fewer than 100 reports in. Looking at the Nine-Year chart, we would have shown numbers more like 1996 than what we knew to be true.

We began to shake the trees. Don sent out e-

mail messages, others made phone calls.

Still we have the lowest number of counties reporting save one. Some of our Forest Service coordinators in the northeast may have had fire duty(?).

Steve Simmons, without his WODU total would have us back at the 1998 level. Walt Carnahan reports for 42 monitors (we counted them). Dick Purvis pulled some more out of the trees. Why is it all of Howard Rathlesberger's 25 reports are in the same handwriting (Howard's)?

Don Yoder wants to make the cutoff September 1st. Is this realistic? What is? ~hg
